Thermolung, Japan opts for Ecofresh Rotors and Bry-Air FFB Dehumidifiers

When SHINNIHON Thermolung, Japan, a NITTETSU Group Company and the birth place of many state-of-the-art world technologies, as well as one of the leading manufacturers of energy recovery wheels signed an agreement with Desiccant Rotors

International (DRI), a Pahwa Enterprise, to buy energy recovery rotors/wheels, it was like taking coal to Newcastle.
